Adult Protective Services (APS)

Adult Protective Services (APS) aims to prevent and remedy the abuse and exploitation of elderly individuals age 65 and older and dependent and vulnerable adults, age 18 and older. The APS program provides protection and remedial activities on behalf of elder and dependent adults unable to protect their own interests, harmed or threatened with harm, or victims of physical or mental injury due to the action or inaction by themselves or other persons.

Provides assistance to eligible aged, blind and disabled individuals who without this care would be unable to remain safely in their own homes. Provides services according to the client's needs, e.g., feeding, bathing, dressing, housekeeping, laundry, shopping errands, meal preparation and meal clean up, respiration, bowel and bladder care, moving in and out of bed, rubbing the skin (to prevent skin breakdown), accompaniment to medical appointments, paramedical services and protective supervision.




