## Scam: Telemarketing by Durable Medical Equipment Suppliers Target: Medicare Customers

The Social Security Act Section 1834 contains a section that prohibits Durable Medical Equipment Suppliers from making unsolicited calls to Medicare beneficiaries unless one of three specific exceptions exist:

- 1. The Medicare beneficiary has given the supplier written permission to telephone.
- 2. The supplier is following up on medical equipment that was previously provided to the beneficiary.
- 3. The supplier has provided at least one covered item to the beneficiary within 15 months preceding the telephone call.

## Scam: Unsolicited Durable Medical Equipment calls!

Payments to suppliers who contact Medicare beneficiaries without one of the exceptions are invalid and are considered a form of fraud.
