SCAM ALERT

Scam: Grandchild Requesting Money Target: Seniors

Beware of telephone calls from persons claiming to be a grandchild and saying he/she has been in an accident or is in jail, and needs money. The caller frequently knows the name of the person he/she is calling, and asks them *not to discuss* the matter with his/her parents. The caller may start the call by saying, "Grandma/Grandpa guess who!"

Follow these tips to avoid giving money to someone who pretends to be a relative:

- Ask other family members if they know about the situation before sending money.
- Ask the grandchild which jail or hospital they are in, and confirm it.
- Do not send money to someone other than the grandchild. if you choose to send money.
- Ask that identification be provided by the grandchild before paying any money.
